

# WHAT'S WRONG WITH...

### ...LOTS OF ADDRESSES IN THE 'TO' BOX?

- **Insecure:** lists of addresses are easy to copy for spam and scams, and email based viruses are spread through lists of contacts.
- Illegal: Under GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), an organisation is not allowed to share individuals' details without their consent, and they must have processes to ensure data protection.
- **Prone to mistakes:** it's easy to accidentally miss people out, use old addresses, reply-all when you don't mean to, etc.
- **Inefficient:** someone needs to keep track of the list, add/remove addresses on request, update details, etc. It's a lot of work!

## ...LOTS OF ADDRESSES IN THE 'BCC' BOX?

- BCC is more secure, but also inefficient and prone to mistakes.
- No 'reply-all' facility: team communications are impossible without keeping everyone in the loop.

...MAILCHIMP? • Insecure and unethical: Mailchimp is owned by facebook, which stores and sells recipients' data for commercial use.

# WHY DISTRIBUTION LISTS ARE THE BEST OPTION

MORE SECURE • No visible lists of recipients' addresses: privacy is respected; scammers are unlikely to copy senders' details individually; and using a distribution list reduces the spread of email based viruses.

- **MORE EFFICIENT** Less effort & fewer mistakes: no need to search for everyone's correct addresses, remember who should be included, etc.
  - User control: people can un/subscribe or update their own details, choose to receive daily or weekly digests, etc.
  - **Adaptable:** settings can be customised based on the group's needs. For example, moderation to prevent spam on large lists.
  - Continuity & longevity: it's easy to shift and share admin tasks, so one person does not need to be responsible for everything.


• **RiseUp** is an activist collective committed to privacy and nonhierarchy. Activists can use their lists and email services for free (donations welcome), which helps spread the word.

## RICSINTERNAL



- Target Audience: RIC Members & Activists
- Purpose: INTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS between activists, e.g. discussion, organising events, reports between groups, etc.
- **Method of joining:** personal request or sign-up sheet at a National Forum or RIC event; self-subscription through email.
- **Spam prevention:** only messages from subscribers are distributed to the list. New subscribers must be approved by a moderator.
- Current subscribers: 130

## **RICSANNOUNCE**



- Target Audience: RIC Members & Supporters
- Purpose: ANNOUNCEMENTS about upcoming events, etc.
- **Method of joining:** self-subscription through the website; self-subscription through email; sign-up sheet at an RIC event.
- **Spam prevention:** all messages and new subscribers must be approved by a moderator.
- Current subscribers: 1979

# COORDINATION TEAMS

(MEDIA, SECRETARIAL, ETC)



- Target Audience: Team members AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC
- **DUAL Purpose: TEAM COMMS + EXTERNAL CONTACT POINT,** e.g. journalists emailing the media team; members emailing for info; etc.
- Method of joining: becoming part of a Coordination Team.
- **Spam prevention:** n/a. Each LIST ADDRESS is available to the public through the RIC website, so some spam is inevitable but personal details of team members are protected.
- Why? Using distribution lists protects everyone's personal details, and ensures someone is always available to deal with incoming email. It was also agreed by RIC members that teams should share responsibility for handling the emails.
- Each team has members from at least THREE local groups.
